The Banquet has multiple purposes, including an enjoyable dinner and a fun evening. But our primary objective is to raise funds that support our education programs and our conservation projects to benefit the fisheries of eastern Idaho. Thanks to your support, the Cutthroats have contributed \$361,718, raised from the past fourteen Expos, to conservation projects and education programs. Conservation projects have received the bulk of these funds, \$340,260, with over \$264,295 supporting Trout Unlimited's programs on the South Fork and Blackfoot Rivers. Other local conservation partners that have benefitted from Expo funds have included the Teton Regional Land Trust, ID Department of Fish & Game, Caribou-Targhee National Forest, Friends of the Teton River, Southeast Idaho Fly Fishers, and the Henry's Fork Foundation. In a long-standing partnership with the Salmon National Forest we have also contributed 30 years of sweat equity working on the Salmon River tributaries.

The Club also conducts many fly-fishing education programs and classes in fly tying, casting and rod building and we recently established a vibrant youth program. But we need volunteers to help with these programs as well as a lot of other activities. These programs and projects provide a great way to meet like-minded people who share a love of fishing. So if you are interested, please contact a Club officer.

We are really pleased to have you with us here tonight and hope you enjoy a pleasant evening. Please consider supporting our conservation and education efforts by purchasing raffle tickets and bidding on live and silent auction items. The trout will love you for it and you will have the added satisfaction of knowing you are giving something back to the fisheries that have given so much to you.



Silent Auction: It will be hard to resist these 50 – 60 quality items, displayed along the south wall of the Ballroom, including quality stocked fly boxes, artwork, books and other miscellaneous fly fishing stuff. The bidding opens during the Banquet social hour and closes before the Live Auction. Minimum bid and bid increments are listed on the bid sheets. Your banquet ticket number is your bidder's number.

Gold Package Prize Raffle: Each of the gold packages has a guaranteed winner. There are 40 of these packages available on a first come first served basis. Each package contains a winning ticket that can be exchanged for an egg. Inside the egg is a number that matches a nice prize displayed at the raffle area (prizes will range in value from \$35 to \$150).



3. Big Sky Anglers Trip



6. South Fork Lodge Fishing and Overnight Package



13. “Tranquility” Giclee Print by Travis Sylvester – ROD ITEM




16. “The Guide” Fly Plate by Bob Jacklin – ROD ITEM

This walnut framed fly plate includes two of Bob Jacklin’s Buzek award-winning flies, the Salmon Fly Dry and the Salmon Fly Nymph. The flies adorn a print of Bob guiding a youngster on the Madison River, illustrating Bob’s belief in the importance a good fishing guide plays as instructor, confidant and companion. This item is also a ROD item, which entitles the purchaser to a 1-in-5 chance of winning a Sage X fly rod valued at over \$900.

Spey fishing for salmon, steelhead, and trout has become all the rage. 18. Three Rivers Ranch Trip

This amazing trip will introduce you to the fabled waters of the Henry’s Fork in the hands of expert guides out of Three Rivers Ranch, a 4th generation family-operated lodge. You and a friend will enjoy two days of fishing. Guide Carlos Chavez is personally donating one of those days and his energetic personality and mastery of fishing are sure to put you onto some nice fish and give you some tips to improve your technique. You can choose any stretch of the Henry’s Fork for your trips. If you are up for the challenging put-in, Carlos is even equipped to fish the Lower Mesa Canyon stretch below Lower Mesa Falls. This piece of water is not for the faint of heart, requiring a ¼ mile hike straight down into the canyon on somewhat of a trail. If you are fit enough to get there, this section is a local jewel that few get to experience. Of course with two hard days of fishing you will need to refuel, so the package also includes dinner at the beautiful Three Rivers Ranch Lodge, nestled between Warm River and Robinson Creek just north of Ashton. Trip is for TWO anglers, including TWO guided days of fishing and a dinner for two. Trip must be taken in the 2019 season.



19. Steven Fernandez Fly Display



Steven Fernandez is a true artist with the bobbin and his fine work shows the great attention to detail and creativity that was recognized by the prestigious Buszek Fly Tying Award in 2012. Steven has the honor of having tied for the legendary Buz Buszek Fly Shop in Visalia, California, which was "Fly Tying Central" for much of the fly fishing industry for decades around the middle of the twentieth century. Beyond his tying talent, he is also a very gracious teacher, willing to share his knowledge with other tiers. Steven's training in architecture and art are evident in the beautifully crafted flies and unique layout of the piece offered tonight. The display features four Catskill quill flies meticulously tied with Steven's artistic touch. We thank Steven for his longtime support of the Expo and generosity in allowing us to feature his work.

20. Custom Fishing Bamboo Fly Rod by John Rivera

John Rivera, a local of Idaho Falls and owner of The Fly Rod Company, has graciously donated a custom built bamboo fly rod that you will surely want to add to your quiver. John has been crafting fine bamboo rods for years, sharing his passion for fly rods and fly fishing with many. This rod is a 2 piece, 8 ft rod with both a 5wt and 6wt tip - basically two rods in one. The bamboo has been flamed, giving it a rich color, and features silver reel hardware and black nickel snake guides. A storage tube and rod sleeve are also included. This isn't your grandpa's bamboo, this is a modern rod design capable of casting big flies in windy conditions and landing big fish -- sounds just like Idaho fishing at its best, doesn't it? Don't miss this opportunity to own and fish with a modern piece of art from a local master.

21. "Spring Cutthroat" - Canvas Print by Bern Sundell

Ennis, Montana artist Bern Sundell knows his fish. This amazing close up of one of our local Yellowstone Cutthroat Trout is so life-like you expect it to swim right out of the frame. Bern began fishing when he was nine and now shares his passion through his art. He is a gifted artist in many forms, a skilled printmaker, potter, and jeweler. His true interest is painting and he loves portraying local fish. Don't miss this opportunity to collect a truly amazing piece to add to your collection and inspire your future dreams of opportunities to search for this wary adversary.



22. Atlantic Salmon Fly Displays by Marvin Nolte

Marvin Nolte is perhaps the most renowned of Atlantic Salmon fly dressers. His immaculate dressings of classic patterns grace numerous books and other media as well as private collections. Called on world-wide to conduct workshops on dressing these exquisite and difficult patterns, he is in the forefront of those enthusiasts that preserve the art of these flies. He has participated in our past Expos conducting workshops on dressing these patterns. Local Atlantic Salmon fly dressers including Gary Barnes and Bruce Staples consider Marvin as their mentor. This year Marvin has donated two beautiful flies to the expo a “Green Highlander” and a “Mar Lodge”. The flies will be sold individually with the highest bidder getting first choice after which the second fly will be auctioned. Don’t miss this opportunity to pick up a beautiful piece of art by such a renowned tier.

23. Ralph Moon Bamboo Rod

Ralph Moon was an accomplished bamboo rod maker and made many rods during his lifetime. He also generously shared his knowledge with other aspiring rod builders, building a legacy that lives on today in the creations of his apprentices. This rod features a very unique spiral blank design. The rod is a 7 ft 6 wt with a down locking reel seat over burl wood and a quality full wells cork grip. The rod was made by Ralph himself, originally purchased by Ed Thomas of Bozeman, Montana, who has donated it to the Snake River Cutthroats to share with another collector. Bamboo rods cast with a certain grace that seems linked to their heritage from a slower, more deliberate time. Modern, space-age graphite composite rods from today cast tight loops at bullet speeds, but seem to lack the quiet patience our sport once embodied. Don’t miss this opportunity to own a hand crafted Ralph Moon fly rod from the golden age of fly fishing. The rod comes with a handmade rod sock and metal case, all as a package that Ralph created.

24. Four Hosts / Four Trips

Back by popular demand! Here's an opportunity to spend a day of fishing, enlightenment, or just 'B.S.ing' with some of the area's most “renowned” fishermen. The trips are all for two people, based upon availability. You and a friend will get to spend an entire day with each of these local experts, fishing some of their favorite local waters. They’re even throwing in lunch for you! This year, the following local legends have signed up for the fun:

- Jimmy Gabettas – Float fishing for smallmouth bass on the Lower Snake River
- Chad Hill – Float fishing on the Teton River or Henry’s Fork
- Chris Hunt – Walk and wade fishing some of Idaho’s pristine backcountry
- Tim Woodard – Float fishing on the South Fork of the Snake River

25. Pike Fishing on Reindeer Lake, Canada with Trout Camp

If you are a streamer fishing addict, you don't want to miss this one. These bad boys are fully capable of eating your trophy 25 inch brown trout and would be happy for the snack. Members from the club have made several trips to Reindeer Lake in Saskatchewan, Canada with the Trout Camp Lodge over the past few years catching a fair number of fish over 40" and even one over 50". This year the Snake River Cutthroats are organizing a club trip and will be at the lodge June 23rd through June 29th. This is a fully inclusive trip for ONE person and includes FIVE full days guided fishing, food, and lodging. Gratuities and travel to and from the lodge are NOT included. Additional spots may be available for \$2,250 per person if you have a friend you want to fish with. We will be traveling up together if you would like to share the travel expenses with others from the club.

26. Leland Howard "Snake River Sunset" Metal Print

We have been fortunate to feature Leland Howard's unmatched works of art at the Expo for several years. As this piece demonstrates, Leland is an amazing photographer and hails from right here in Shelley, Idaho. Once again, this year he fascinates us with his stunning photography of places that are familiar to many. This year we are offering *Snake River Sunset*, depicting some beautiful fall foliage on the canyon stretch of the river we all know so well. The piece is infused into a coated aluminum sheet, creating vibrant colors not achievable with traditional printing. You don't have to be a fly-fisher to recognize the beauty of Leland's work and be proud to display the natural beauty of the wonderful South Fork.

27. 2019 ClackaCraft 16ft EDDY Drift Boat

Combining characteristics of the 16' Low Profile and HeadHunter Skiff, the Eddy is capable of sneaking through tight spots with ease, even when fully loaded. Quick enough for the Beaverhead, yet stable enough for the Yellowstone, the Eddy is ideally suited for a wide variety of rivers and situations. Gone are the days of sacrificing row-ability for maneuverability. Go ahead, let the big guy sit in back, bolt on the motor; the Eddy can handle it.
